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THE GRANTOR Catharine Laird, the widow of John Laird, De-  
ceased of the Town of Pendleton of the County of Jefferson and  
State of Illinois for and in consideration of Ten Dollars, in  
hand paid, doth hereby grant, bargain and sell, convey and  
warrant to James M. Walters, Frank A. Johnson, David M. Blake,  
William H. Williamson and Henry H. Payne as the Trustees of the  
United Brethren Church known as the Union Grove Class at the  
Laird Cemetery in Jefferson County, State of Illinois and to  
their successors in office.....

this deed is to convey the land hereinafter described  
for the purpose of having a church house built on said  
land and whenever it ceases to be used as church pro-  
perty the land is to revert back to the original owner  
or her legal heirs, the following described Real Es-  
tate, to wit: Commencing at the North West corner of  
the North West fourth of the South East quarter of  
Section Thirteen (13) and than runs due South about  
Twenty rods so as to join on to the land deed to the  
Laird cemetery or its Trustees by Jacob Shrum and  
thence due East with the North line of said cemetery  
four rods and thence to run due North about twenty rods

and thence due West fore rods to the place of beginning so as to contain one half acre lying along on the East side of the Public Road and North of the West end of the Laird Cemetery; all in Township three (3) South Range Four (4) East of the 3rd P.M.

situated in the County of Jefferson in the State of Illinois, hereby releasing and waiving all rights under and by virtue of the Homestead Exemption Laws of this State.
